The Responsible Service of Alcohol (SITHFAB002-Provide responsible service of alcohol) The Responsible Conduct of Gambling (SITHGAM001- Provide responsible gambling services)

Belmont High School will enable students to gain industry recognised Hospitality qualifications at school to help assist students with future pathways and directions. The school will run the RSA & RCG courses on two days at the school library.

The Responsible Service of Alcohol (SITHFAB002-Provide responsible service of alcohol) otherwise known as RSA is a 6.5 hour course that allows participants to be eligible for a NSW Competency Card as issued by Liquor and Gaming New South Wales.

The Responsible Conduct of Gambling (SITHGAM001- Provide responsible gambling services) otherwise known as RCG is a 6.5 hour course delivered in classroom. This unit of competency is the foundation for the mandatory Responsible Conduct of Gambling training for all new hoteliers, secretary managers and gaming-related staff in order to satisfy the requirements of the Liquor and Gaming Regulations of NSW.

Before commencing this course students must attain a "Unique Student Identifier" Number.
