Career Choices for High School Students - TAFE NSW

Year 11 Future Direction Interviews

Year 11 student will participate in Future Directions interviews this term- date TBC. It's a wellbeing and academic check-in with an action plan discussing key school questions.

Examples:

- Current school subjects
- What is your future direction? What do you want to do 'post-school'?
- Will you complete 10 units in Year 12 or keep your 12 Year 11 units? What subject will you drop?
- Action Plan
- Goal 1- Set a goal for Year 11 studies.
- Goal 2- Set a goal for Year 12 studies
- Goal 3- Set a goal for life (general/personal).

This is essential conversation that all students need to attend. The interviews will run on a normal school day with students attending their 15min interview during class time.



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YEAR 12 EXIT INTERVIEWS

All Year 12 students will be individually interviewed this term to plan their post school direction and 'exit' plan from Belmont High School. This involves a 15min interview with the Careers Adviser and Senior Learning Hub Coordinator. Students will evaluate current school progress, set goals and discuss future directions (university, work, further education).\

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WORK EXPERIENCE FOR YEAR 10'S

Work experience provides a general introduction to the 'world of work'. Students are able to observe a variety of work, usually in a field of their choice, and undertake supervised tasks appropriate to their skill level. Work experience builds on a student's career planning and transition activities in school and can assist their course and subject choices in senior high school.

Work experience dates 2023:

Term 3 - Sept (Mon 11-15)

Term 4 - Nov (Mon 27- Dec 1).

Students are encouraged to complete work experience at least once throughout the year but can complete up to four placements. Students need to be organised and have all paperwork completed, signed and approved

before commencement. Students are encouraged to source their own placement via friends, family, local community or approaching businesses of interest.



All work experience paperwork available via Year 10 Canvas group or hardcopies outside the Careers office.

BE ORGANISED

Students need to be organised- check their school email weekly, check daily notices and their Year group pages in Canvas to make sure they are accessing all the opportunities on offer.








