INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

THE YEAR 7 CAPA ENRICHMENT CLASS PROGRAM

The enrichment class encompasses the NSW Education Standards Authority Dance, Drama, Music, and Visual Arts syllabus content. The course of study offers Year 7 students a combined creative arts experience. After completing one year in the program students will be assessed on whether they will continue in this class for Year 8 at BHS. From years 9 - 12 students will have the option to choose their focus arts discipline/s for elective study.

CAPA students will have the opportunity to explore their chosen art form in a wide variety of classroom experiences and extra-curricular activities that run within the school community. Public performance opportunities, mentoring and tuition from specialist teachers (during the school day) is available to support your child.

Students who are accepted into the program are identified as being talented and/or gifted in the Creative and/or Performing Arts and their classwork, programming and assessment in all subject areas will encompass their background, skills and talents. Specific teachers in all KLAs will be selected to teach this class and can cater to their preferred learning styles across all the mandatory subjects.

More importantly, classwork, programming and assessment in all subject areas considers the students' backgrounds, skills and talents. The experience offered to CAPA Program students is holistic and inclusive. The curriculum does not narrow the learning experiences to include creative and performing arts subjects only, but attempts to cater to a preferred learning style in all mandatory studies. There will be an emphasis for **Project Based Learning** experiences, during which students will present a range of individual and group tasks.

We are sure that the BHS Year 7 CAPA program will further develop your child's knowledge, skills and attitudes and enable them to reach their full artistic potential as well as fully achieving in their general education.

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It is intended, as part of the learning philosophy around this program, that students will participate in one or more of the extra-curricular activities offered by the school.

Requirements for Audition Applications

Students may audition in one or two of the Performing/Creative Arts areas but will need to complete individual auditions or portfolio submissions in each area.

Information about the audition procedure, including time and date, will be forwarded to you by mail approximately two weeks prior to the audition.

Supporting documentation addressing the selection criteria provided in your application will be assessed by the school in addition to the skills demonstrated in the audition process.

Unsuccessful applications will receive feedback as requested.

PLEASE NOTE

- CAPA Enrichment Class packages will be available from Belmont High School from **Tuesday 3**rd **April 2018** (packages will also be available to download from the BHS website http://www.belmont-h.schools.nsw.edu.au/home).
- Applications are to be submitted to Belmont High School by **Friday 11th May 2018.**
- Students will be notified by mail of audition date and time by **Friday 18th May 2018.**
- Auditions will be held at Belmont High School hall on **Tuesday 29th May 2018**
- Students will be notified of the result of their audition via Australia Post no later than Friday 6th July 2018. This will be either an offer, a reserve offer or a declination.

DANCE

- 1. Prepare a 2-minute dance sequence in student's choice of dance style. Bring a backing track.
- 2. Appropriate Dance attire or comfortable clothes that allow you to easily move.
- 3. Appropriate dance shoes and no jewellery to be worn.
- 4. Students to have hair tied back and off their face.
- 5. Take part in a modern/contemporary Dance Workshop for 60 minutes. This consists of the following: Teacher lead warm-ups, Technical skills, and a Choreographic Workshop in which students will be required to perform the learnt sequence in small groups.

DRAMA

- 1. Prepare a 1 to 2 minute scripted monologue of student's own choosing. No poetry please or self-written scripts.
- 2. Take part in a one hour Drama Improvisation Workshop.
- 3. Wear comfortable clothing that you can easily move in.

MUSIC

- 1. Prepare a piece of music no longer than 4 minutes that demonstrates both your technical ability and expression.
- 2. Bring your instrument and music to the audition.
- 3. A piano, drum kit and amplifiers are available for use if you wish. Vocalist will have the option to sing acoustically or with a microphone.
- 4. Backing tracks or accompanist if required.

VISUAL ARTS

- 1. Students need to prepare a portfolio of their artmaking. This can be compiled from work that they have completed at home, school or in any extra-curricular activity.
- 2. Students will participate in a one hour Visual Arts Workshop where they will be asked to complete a series of tasks that are designed to identify their skills and strengths.
