Star Struck Rehearsals and Show Week Info 2019

Star Struck Show week is fast approaching! We are only 3 weeks out from one of the most exciting school events! Our first Major rehearsal is on next Thursday the 30th May at Newcastle Entertainment Centre. Our next rehearsals are on the week of Star Struck leading into the performances.

Please read the following information CAREFULLY.

Thurs 30th May: Major Movement Rehearsal: Students are to be at Belmont High School Bus Bay at 7.45am to catch an 8am bus. The bus will arrive back to school in time for usual school buses. We will be back at about 3pm. CHOIR ARE NOT INVOLVED IN THIS REHEARSAL.

Wednesday 12th June: Major Movement Rehearsal 2: Students to be at the bus bay 7.45am for an 8am depart. Finish time approx. 5.30pm. Estimated arrival back to school is 6pm, however the rehearsal schedule has not been released, so the end time is yet to be confirmed.

Thursday 13th **June:** Tech & Dress Rehearsal: Students to be at the bus bay at 8.45am for a 9am depart. Finish time is approx. 5.30pm, estimated arrival back to school is 6pm, however the show run time may vary from last year, so the end time is yet to be confirmed. Students will need costumes and make-up for this rehearsal. Photos are taken on this day. Costumes are then kept at the venue (in the allocated tent) overnight in preparation for first show the next day. Students are welcome to bring comfort items such as pillows and blankets on this day to leave in the tent.

Friday 14th June: SHOW DAY #1: 7.55am arrival at the bus bay for an 8am depart. First show is a matinee at 10.30am. Students must have make-up and hair done ready for the matinee performance PRIOR to catching the bus at 8am. We have arranged to supervise students between the matinee and night performance. We are catching a bus to Kotara to allow students to get some 'retail therapy' and to provide options for dinner. Students will need to bring money for dinner and their best behaviour! We will catch the bus back to school after the night performance and arrive at Belmont High Bus Bay at approx. 11pm.

Saturday 16th June: SHOW DAY #2: 11.45am <u>Meet at</u> the Entertainment Centre at 12.30pm. Students must have make-up and hair done ready for the matinee performance. Students will stay at the venue between the matinee and night performance. We will be getting pizzas and drinks for \$5 per student in the break. Alternate food must be organised yourself. THERE WILL BE NO BUS HOME FROM THE NIGHT PERFORMANCE. Students to get their own way home from the venue at 10.30pm. Students should arrange to carpool. Parents/Carers MUST pick up students from inside the venue in view of the teacher. Please note that there is NO BUS on this day.

Show times: Friday 10.30am and 7pm Saturday 2pm and 7pm

Please note: Parents watching the show must take their child home otherwise the bus will beat your car back to the school as the traffic becomes congested and we have kids waiting very late.

As you can tell from above, show week is a very busy and exhausting time. Please ensure that you are well rested prior to the week and are eating healthy foods and snacks amongst all the 'junk food' or you will not last. We often have problems with students getting headaches and belly aches from eating too much sugary foods! Stay well hydrated!

What Students Should Bring

Students will be given a wrist band which MUST stay on for the remainder of the week. You will NOT be allowed to enter the backstage tents without it and we only get given the specified amount. This is your responsibility. Please ensure you have appropriate underwear and bras for girls. This means skin colour- no bright colours as it can be seen through costumes.
